Presenting the Annual KODAK Gallery Awards

The KODAK Gallery Awards were introduced in 1985 as a way to honor and promote the importance and value of excellence in professional photography. Products and services from KODAK PROFESSIONAL Imaging Solutions have always represented imaging excellence for professional photographers. We are honored to elevate the importance of professional quality imaging within the industry.

In 2017 we are streamlining the process for submissions, making it easier for you to participate with updated rules and making the KODAK Gallery and KODAK Gallery Elite Awards more exclusive than ever before.

Gallery Awards will be presented at the annual Professional Photographers of America (PPA) district conventions. One Gallery Award will be named in each district with 5 total photographers selected nationally. Each of these winners will be eligible to compete for The Gallery Elite Award, which will be judged at the annual Imaging USA conference and trade show with those winners representing the “best of the best.” Entrants must also be entered into the PPA International Photographic Competition (IPC).



KODAK Gallery Award Qualifications

To qualify for the KODAK Gallery Elite Award, your submission must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Your original entry must have been produced and printed on KODAK PROFESSIONAL Media with the support of a recognized Professional Lab.**
2. Your original entry must also be entered into PPA's International Photographic Competition.
3. A submitted image may only win one KODAK Gallery Award.
4. Your print must receive a minimum of 80 points in PPA District Judging in order to be considered.

***Photographers must own copyrights to each entry and to have in his/ her possession signed and dated releases for each subject, model and location. By entering the competition, the photographer acknowledges and accepts this complete responsibility and grants Kodak Alaris use of the entry.**

KODAK Gallery Elite Award Qualifications

The KODAK Gallery Elite Award honors the “best of the best.” It is one more way to showcase outstanding, high-quality images, further elevating the art of professional photographers, as well as thanking them, their associates, and clients, who have helped make the Gallery Elite Award a symbol of photographic excellence.

If you are chosen as a KODAK Gallery Award winner, you are eligible to compete for the prestigious KODAK Gallery Elite Award.

When a KODAK Gallery Award winner chooses to compete at the next level, the KODAK Gallery Elite Award competition, the entrant must meet the following requirements.

1. Print or album must have won a district KODAK Gallery Award.
2. **Original entry must have been produced on and printed on KODAK PROFESSIONAL Media with the support of recognized Professional Lab.**
3. A hard copy print of the submitted image must be sent for judging at the PPA International Photographic Competition (IPC). IPC Case and Image Numbers will be required to register an image for consideration.

**Failure to document the type of KODAK PROFESSIONAL Media that was used and the Professional Lab that printed your image will disqualify the entry from being considered for the Gallery and the Gallery Elite Award.*
